



FLORIDA FIREFIGHTERS CANCER BENEFIT

Some cancers have been determined to be a major occupational hazard for Firefighters. In 2019 it was legislated in Florida that when certain conditions are met, upon a Florida Firefighter being diagnosed with cancer they should immediately receive a \$25,000 lump sum benefit. The Midlands Florida Firefighters Cancer Benefit group policy assists counties, municipalities and other public entities with the financial burden of the new legislation.

- First diagnosis cancer benefit - lump sum \$25,000
- First diagnosis benefit continuation
- Cancer death benefit - \$75,000
- Payment of benefits is subject to the following:
 - Covered cancer diagnosis is made while the firefighter's coverage is in force under the policy
 - The Firefighter has been employed as a Firefighter with the employer for 5 continuous years
- Direct claims administration
- Premium \$288 per firefighter
- Simplified process for quote/purchase/enrollment
- Group enrollment only
